Bug Club - Nature Shapes -Lesson 3. Quiet and loud! Show page 8 of the book Nature Shapes and say "Shell starts with /sh/".To Sit together in a circle and explain that you are going to play a speaking and listening game. One person starts by saying a word quietly to the person next to them and then this person says the word loudly! Challenge children to think of different words to say in different ways. Encourage them to repeat words back in the same way that they were said to them. Extend by asking them all to copy the opposite way, so if someone says a word quietly, can everyone say it
